BIOTECHNOLOGY & GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICE TRAINING COURSES (QUINCY CAMPUS)

These training courses are designed for researchers, laboratory technicians, manufacturing technicians, QC and QA Personnel, and Chemistry and Biology students.

ÄKTA PURE

ÄKTA pure is an easily customizable liquid chromatography system designed for protein purification. The UNICORN software comes with a library containing a wide variety of column parameters and predefined method templates to increase productivity and efficiency. High pressure and air bubble sensors are incorporated in the system to allow unattended runs. A programmable email feature is available to notify operators when an alarm is triggered.

GAS CHROMATOGRAPHY

Gas Chromatography is an analytical technique commonly used in research, environmental and forensic laboratories to separate and identify a mixture of thermally stable and volatile substances. A mobile phase, generally an inert carrier gas such as nitrogen, helium, argon or carbon dioxide is used to carry the substances through a heated stationary phase (column). A detector located at the end of the column provides quantitative measurements of the components in the mixture as they elute together with the carrier gas.

HIGH LIQUID PERFORMANCE CHROMATOGRAPHY

High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) is a powerful analytical technique widely used to separate, quantify, purify, and identify molecules from compound mixtures. Most HPLC applications are found in testing food and biopharmaceutical products, identifying narcotics, and analyzing environmental pollutants.
