Associate of Science Degree in Nursing (ASN)

Prerequisites (MUST be completed by May 17, 2019)

- *Proof of high school/GED completion*
 - *If GED, scores must be included. We will not accept just the certificate.*
- *Official college transcripts from previously attended colleges including QC*
- *Attend a Nursing Information Session*
- *TEAS exam*
- *English Composition I*
- *College level math (College Algebra or Statistics. Statistics is preferred)*

***Prerequisite science courses may be in progress, but must be successfully completed (C or better) by August 9, 2019**

- *General Biology w/lab*
- *Anatomy & Physiology I w/lab*

***Sciences must have been taken within the last 5 years (Fall 2014 or later)**

**General Biology is required because it is a prerequisite for Microbiology which is within the program. Bio must be taken prior to taking Microbiology

***A&P II is not a prerequisite, but applicants are strongly encouraged to complete this course prior to the start of the program.

TEAS Exam

- MUST be taken at Quincy College
- On or after September 1, 2018 but prior to May 17, 2019
- Maximum of two attempts allowed (must wait 30 days prior to retesting)
- There are now required scores in each section
 - Math 63%
 - English 60%
 - Reading 74%
 - Science 55%

Certificate of Completion in Practical Nursing (PN)

Prerequisites

- *Proof of high school/GED completion*
 - *If GED, scores must be included. We will not accept just the certificate.*
- *Attend a Nursing Information Session*
- *TEAS exam*

TEAS Exam

- MUST be taken at Quincy College
- On or after September 1, 2018 but prior to May 17, 2019
- Maximum of two attempts allowed (must wait 30 days prior to retesting)
- Required scores in each section:
 - Math 50%
 - English 55%
 - Reading 65%

Other Important Information

*The application deadlines are as follows:

- The Early Action Deadline is Wednesday, May 1, 2019.
- The Regular Decision Deadline is Friday, May 17, 2019.

*Both programs are FULL TIME DAYS (students should plan to be available 7am-4pm)

*Sciences must have been taken in the last 5 years

*NO WAIVERS

*This is a brand new program, so no preference will be given to previous nursing students. Everyone starts from scratch.

*Once students have applied and submitted all required documents their information will be given to the Nursing Dept. They will grade each applicant using a rubric. Students with the highest scores will be contacted to come in for an interview and on the spot writing sample. The committee will then meet to make decisions.

*No bridge program (LPN to RN) at this time

*Priority consideration will be given to students who have successfully completed Microbiology, A&P II, English Composition II, General Psychology, Human Growth & Development and U.S History/Government core. All applicants will be scored using an admission rubric.

*The Nursing Programs tuition will be available upon release of the Fall 2019 tuition college wide.

* Take your prerequisite science courses this summer.

- The two prerequisite science classes you need for the ASN Program are Anatomy & Physiology I w/Lab (BIO 131) and General Biology w/Lab (BIO 111) and they need to be completed by August 9, 2019 - which most summer sessions are! View the Summer Schedules online at quincycollege.edu/summer

Nursing Scholarships Available

To be Eligible Students Must:

- * Be accepted and enrolled full time in the Quincy College Nursing Program Fall 2019
- * Complete and submit an application with required essay by May 1st or 17th of 2019
