



Student Scholarship Program

Quincy Credit Union Student Scholarship Lottery Program will award four \$1,000 college scholarships to eligible high school seniors in the present year's graduating class and/or enrolled undergraduates currently attending an accredited U.S. College or University. Eligibility requirements are listed below:

For High School Seniors:

1. Student applicant must be a Member with Primary Share Account in their own name and in good standing at Quincy Credit Union.
2. Applicant must be a high school senior in the present year's High School graduating class actively pursuing acceptance into an accredited college/university undergraduate program.
3. Applicant must complete Scholarship Package which includes
 - a. Completed QCU Application.
 - b. Copy of acceptance letter or proof of application from College/University.

For enrolled undergraduates currently attending a U.S. College or University:

1. Student applicant must be a Member with Primary Share Account in their own name and in good standing at Quincy Credit Union.
2. Must complete Scholarship Package which includes:
 - a. Completed QCU Application
 - b. Official, recent college Transcripts

Deadline: Complete application package must be postmarked no later than

The first business day of March

Lottery selection of the winners will be made by the Scholarship Committee. Awards will be paid directly to scholarship winners upon documentation of **second semester enrollment** unless recipient is enrolled in an undergraduate program, in which case a copy of the spring semester invoice will be accepted. Only complete applications will be considered. Eligible applicants may apply each year they meet program requirements however; recipients are limited to one scholarship award. Applicants may not apply if they have already received a scholarship award. No alternates will be accepted. Completed scholarship packages can be mailed to:
