

COURSES FOR SELECTIVE PROGRAMS

Quincy College offers a number of programs that have selective admissions. These are programs a student has applied to in addition to general admissions into Quincy College. These courses are meant to be taken by students who are enrolled in specific programs, and have applied for these specialty programs through the Admissions Office. Students who take these designated courses codes must be enrolled in the following programs.

MLT = Medical Laboratory Technician Program

PHB = Phlebotomy Program

PNU = Practical Nursing Program

PTA = Physical Therapist Assistant Program

RNU = Associate Degree in Nursing Program

SUR = Surgical Technology Program

CNA = Certified Nursing Assistant
