
## USING THE GPA CALCULATOR


- Log into the QC student portal using your student ID# and password. You can log into your student portal here: https://register.quincycollege.edu/ICS/
- 2. Choose the "Student" option from the tabs at the top of the page:




3. From the Student landing page, choose "My Academic Advising" from the side of the page:



4. From the "My Academic Advising" landing page, click on the down arrow next to My Academic Advising on the side of the page, and choose GPA Calculator:




5. You will be brought to the GPA Calculator tool, be sure division is listed as "undergraduate" and click "go":



6. You will then be asked to provide your expected grade in each of your registered courses, this should be a realistic expectation of how you think you will do. Once you select your grades,

## click on Create Projection:




7. Once you create your GPA projection you will be given the projection of the semester GPA and your overall GPA including the courses you have already completed:

Uncheck the Include checkbox for any un-graded courses you do not wish to include in the projection. For each of the remaining un-graded courses, enter a projected grade and press the Create Projection button.

A career GPA estimate will be calculated based on your current career GPA (displayed above) and the grades you provide. Also, a GPA will be calculated for just the selected courses.

Note: GPA projection does not take into account repeat logic for repeat courses or for courses that do not count for graduation
