Quincy College Academic Division of Nursing Preparing for the HESI A2 Admission Exam

The **HESI Admission Assessment (A2)** tests program applicants in three main academic areas – **English Language, Math, & Science**. This test is designed to assess the academic and personal readiness of prospective students in nursing and health professions.

The **English Language** portion of the test includes the following sub-categories:

- <u>Reading Comprehension (55 Questions)</u>: Provides reading scenarios in order to measure reading comprehension, identifying the main idea, finding meaning of words in context, passage comprehension, making logical inferences, etc.
- <u>Vocabulary and General Knowledge (55 Questions)</u>: Contains vocabulary terms that are commonly used in both general English-speaking settings and in health care fields.
- <u>Grammar (55 Questions)</u>: Contains basic grammar, including parts of speech, important terms, and their uses, commonly occurring grammatical errors, etc.

The **Math** portion of the test covers the following (55 Questions):

• <u>Basic Math Skills (Recommended Time 50 Minutes)</u>: Focuses on math skills needed for health care fields, including basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, fractions, decimals, ratio and proportion, household measures, general math facts, etc.

The **Science** portion of the test includes the following sub-categories:

- <u>Biology (30 Questions)</u>: Covers biology basics, water, biological molecules, metabolism, cells, cellular respiration, photosynthesis, etc.
- <u>Chemistry (30 Questions)</u>: Contains test items that cover matter, chemical equations and reactions, the periodic table, atomic structure, nuclear chemistry, chemical bonding, etc.
- <u>Anatomy and Physiology (30 Questions)</u>: Provides coverage of general terminology and anatomical structures and systems.
