- Contact <u>advising@quincycollege.edu</u>. An Advisor will assist you with course selection, availability and schedule.
- Current students taking classes at Quincy College, email Kate Lopci, AVP of Workforce Development for information at klopci@quincycollege.edu.

Once above steps have been completed, email the TOP application forms directly to klopci@quincycollege.edu. Furthermore, students are required to sign Part A prior to submitting their application.

Based on the Department of Unemployment Assistance, (DUA) requirements-

- Students are required to submit all of the paperwork pertaining to their unemployment benefits directly to the DUA. The College does not take responsibility for submitting your application to the DUA. Failure to follow the process, will affect your benefits.
