

Radiologic Technology Program Admissions Ranking Sheet

The Radiologic Technology Program is a selective admission program. It uses a point system to determine acceptance. All applications which are complete by the deadline (including receipt of TEAS scores, transcripts, etc.) will be ranked according to this system. The top ranked applicants will be accepted. Please refer to the website for information concerning what occurs after acceptance and prior to beginning the program. The following is an explanation of the point system.

Pre-requisite Courses: These courses must be completed, and a grade reported prior to the application deadline.
